Dr. Masayuki Nomura is the Senior Vice President and General Manager for NTT Communications Corporation's Broadband IP Services Business Division. He is responsible for broadband services such as Internet, MPLS-VPN, Ethernet VPN and value added services over broadband services such as VoIP and Web & Mail Hosting and established those services as the leading services in Japan. Dr. Nomura directs the NTT Communication's IP service planning and development.

Prior to NTT communication's spin off from NTT, Dr.Nomura was the General Manager of the Packet Business Division at NTT. He initiated Frame Relay service for NTT, which became the biggest Frame Relay service in Japan.

Before his position as General Manager of the Packet Business Division of NTT, Dr.Nomura was a board member of NTT-PC communications, which is a subsidiary company of NTT and was responsible for business planning then built a base of NTT-PC's Internet business.

Before NTT-PC, Dr. Nomura was involved in the development of packet switching systems, particularly for the architecture and protocols. He also headed the developments of the packet switching services in NTT. He was also involved with standardization of X.25 and X.400.

Dr. Nomura has a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from Keio University. He also has a Masters degree of Mathematical Sciences from Nagoya University, as well as a doctorate degree in Telecommunication from Keio University.
