Malachy Moynihan is the vice president of Engineering and Product Marketing at Linksys, a division of Cisco Systems. In this role, Moynihan leads several departments at Linksys, including product development, management, marketing and training. Moynihan helped develop Cisco's consumer product strategy that culminated into the Linksys acquisition.

Moynihan is still responsible for managing products at Linksys as part of the acquisition.

Moynihan joined Cisco in June 2000 through the acquisition of Infogear Technology Corp., an early technology provider of consumer and service provider internet appliance products, where he was vice president of Operations. At Infogear, Moynihan was responsible for operations, ODM management, hardware product development, network infrastructure and technical support. Prior to Infogear, Moynihan was the director of Operations for the Performa (Consumer) product group at Apple Computer, responsible for all consumer and educational product operations and external product development. During his tenure at Apple, Moynihan worked in Europe and the United States, and was responsible for introducing Apple to Asian and international ODM management. Earlier in his career, he worked in research and business development for several international companies and the Irish government.

Moynihan holds a degree in electrical engineering from the National University of Ireland and has completed post-graduate studies in technology, business and finance at INSEAD, France and Ohio State University.
