## Clive Dutton, OBE

As director of planning and regeneration and acting strategic director for the Development Directorate of Birmingham, England, Clive Dutton manages the largest local authority planning, urban regeneration, highways and transportation and building consultancy department in Europe.

Previous appointments include director of regeneration at JJ Gallagher Ltd—one of the largest private strategic developers in the country—and head of Regeneration at Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council.

He has extensive experience of working with partnerships, including membership on the team which produced the United Kingdom Government's Urban White Paper in 2000.

Dutton was chief executive of Tipton City Challenge and general manager of Black Country Development Corporation and has worked for a number of other local authorities.

He has undertaken various work for government including: the Urban Task Force, Urban White Paper, the Oldham Independent Review (following the 2001 civil disturbances), the Gaeltacht Quarter, Belfast, and the current Department for Communities and Local Government (DCLG) Planning Reform Board. Dutton is chairman of the DCLG (formerly Deputy Prime Minister's) Annual Sustainable Communities Award.

Dutton was awarded an OBE (Order of the British Empire) in 1998 for services to regeneration of the West Midlands.
