For more than ten years Peter Lindlahr has served in leadership positions for the state government of the Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg, Germany. Since March 2007 he has been heading the newly established Coordination Center for Climate Issues. In this position he is responsible for administering the city's ambitious Climate Action Plan, which aims to reduce annual CO2 emissions by two million tons until 2012. He is also director of the energy department of the Ministry of Urban Development and Environment.

Amongst his prior duties were sectoral planning and controlling for health services and consumer protection, serving on the supervisory board of the State Hospital Corporation, and heading the minister's office in the Ministry of Health and Environment and the Ministry of Urban Development and Environment.

Peter Lindlahr is a lawyer by training. He graduated from law school at the university of Bonn, Germany, and clerked with the Hanseatic High Court in Hamburg, Germany.
