In Los Angeles, he led his own architecture and planning consulting practice, serving private and public sector clients. Wagener was a professor at the architecture and urban planning schools at the University of California, Los Angeles, and the University of Southern California. He is also the author of "Raphael Soriano," published by Phaidon Press, the biography of a talented architect working in post-WWII Los Angeles, who was a dedicated advocate of the new building materials and construction techniques developed at the time.

Born in Essen, Germany, Wagener received a master's degree and doctorate in architecture and urban planning from RWTH Aachen University in Germany, and an advanced management degree from Harvard University.
